7.01 Executive Director's Report: 196 K-7, 20 Daycare

-We had two new students come and two students enrolled who did not come, so we had a net loss of zero. We had a short delay for the second daycare room opening due to lack of applicants but we are now at 20. The second room will be up and running starting the Monday after spring break. If we grow enrollment up to 40, other applicants for daycare were qualified. For MCA testing, we pushed back our reading date to April to allow more time to prepare, but also to give the test after Ramadan and fasting. After the reading test, we will have a week break and also celebrate culture night. Then the following week we will have Math MCA. Science MCA remains the same. The testing windows for each test have also been shortened from 2 weeks to one week. Spring NWEA will also remain the same for K-2 and 4, 6, 7 science NWEA.
